- Categorizes job codes as labor, material, equipment, subcontracting, overhead, miscellaneous, or as a consolidating type.
- Tracks estimated costs, actual costs, and changes in estimated costs from change orders for jobs, phases, and job code detail.
- Calculates overhead costs based on fixed amounts, percentage of costs, actual costs incurred, or your actual payroll overhead.

▲ Profit/Loss Report
